




YOU Can Draw a Bird in Six Easy Steps

What? You say you can't draw? Sure you can.

If you can draw  a circle  an oval and  a triangle,

then you can draw a bird following these simple steps:

1. First draw an circle for its head.



2. Then attach an oval for it's body.



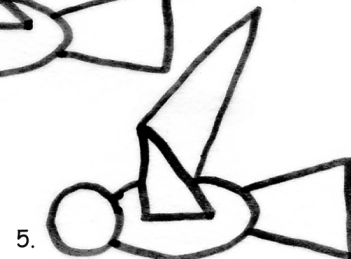
3. Add a long triangle for its tail.



4. Use a triangle for its shoulder.

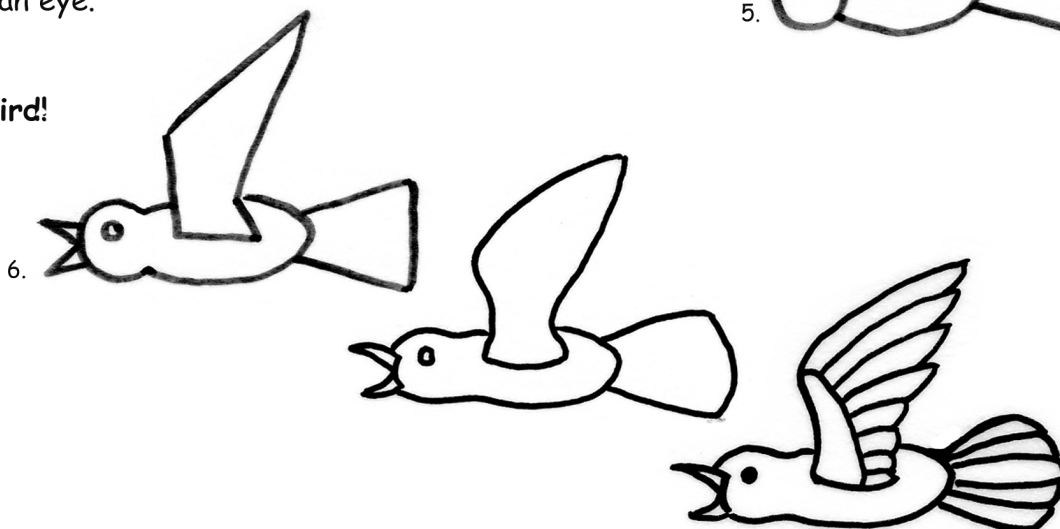


5. And another triangle for it's upper wing.



6. Draw two little triangles for a beak and a little bitty circle for an eye.

You just drew a bird!



Now you can curve the lines, add detail, and color the bird, if you like.

The really fun part about drawing birds is that you start learning more about them.

What would you do to your drawing if you wanted it to be a cardinal, a woodpecker, or an eagle?
